

## Literacy

**Handwriting:** letter formation, developing accuracy of letters and making sure they are sitting on the line.

Developing the accuracy of finger spacing between words.

**Fiction writing:** Sequencing sentences to form short narratives. Using joining words and joining clauses using 'and'. Focus on re-reading what is written to check it makes sense.

**Non-fiction writing:** Understanding text types i.e. newspaper articles. Understanding and using facts.

**SPAG:** (spelling, punctuation and grammar) Accurate and confident use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

**Phonics:** Focused Group phonics. Focus on building understanding of Phase 5 sounds, spelling common exception words and applying phonics in reading and writing.

**Key Texts:** Charlie and the Chocolate Factory & Chocolate from Bean to Bar.

## Science

-Identify everyday materials around me such as wood and metal that make a table.

- Understand and be able to name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, metal, glass and rock.

- Describe the physical properties of different materials.

- Sort objects made of different materials into different categories

-Investigating melting and cooling different materials and how they change

-Looking at famous scientists like Charles Macintosh and their discoveries

## Numeracy

Recognising and writing numbers

Revisiting number bonds and known facts.

**Measures Money:** Recognise all coins, use addition and subtraction skills in a money context, make simple amounts as part of shopping scenarios.

**Multiplication and Division:** Count on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s, link repeated addition to multiplication, begin to use doubling and halving.

**Geometry: Shape** Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.
