If possible can we ask that books are returned **on Wednesdays** to allow class teachers opportunity to mark any homework that has been completed before the new homework is sent home. Thank you.

- To support our topic learning, you may wish to complete additional tasks and projects using some of the ideas below. These are only suggested activities and we welcome your creativity so if your child has a different idea that links to the topic- brilliant!
- All of these amazing projects will be showcased later in the term for everyone to see! For the end of term please could all homework books be in school by Friday 13th December as we intend to have a final homework sharing on Tuesday 17th December.

Possible Ideas for Sweets Galore:

- Design a sweet wrapper
- Make your own sweets and write the recipe
- Make a poster for a brand of sweets (or your own if you prefer)
- Draw your own sweets factory
- Make up a rhyme or poem about your sweets
- Research how your favourite sweets are made or where they come from
- Do a survey about favourite sweets of people you know and draw a simple chart to show this
- Create a sweet shop price list and decide how much you could buy for 10p? 20p? £1.00? etc..
- Any other idea you may have!
