May we please remind you to send your child to school with the correct clothing and equipment.

On a **daily basis** children should bring in a bottle of water and their book bag; we do try and read with them as often as possible. As the weather is warming up, a sun hat/cap is essential. We do encourage you to apply sun cream on your child before coming to school. **PE Kits** must include a white t-shirt, navy blue/black shorts/skort and pair of trainers/daps **that fit!** Lots of children are complaining that their daps do not fit. **Swimming kits** must have a swim suit, swimming hat, goggles and a towel. If your child is taking part in **Forest School** they may wear their own clothes to school on that day and bring their uniform in a bag to change in to after. Forest school clothes should be weather appropriate **but** children must wear long sleeves and full length trousers/leggings/joggers for protection.
